Glossary - Temple Aliyah

Chol ha'moed - term for the intermediate days of Passover and Sukkot Erev Chag - day preceding Shabbat or Festival Sefirat Ha'omer - the daily counting of the the omer period which begins on the second night of Passover and continues until Shavuot Nissan - first month of the Jewish calendar Yom Tov - lit good day; refers to a festival
